## It is Harvest Time

## IT IS HARVEST TIME – Powerful, Prophetic, Timely ASC 2020 Conference (July 31– Aug 2)

*“His winnowing fork is in His hand, and He will clear His threshing floor, gathering His wheat into His barn.” (Matthew 3:12)*

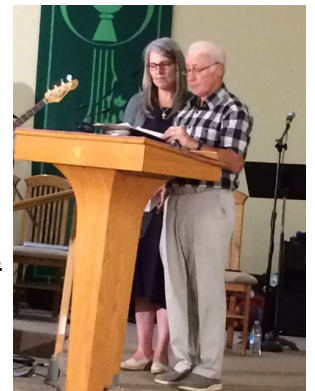
And gathering He did! After months of prayer and planning the Atlantic Service Committee successfully executed our first ever “virtual conference”.

Inspired praise and worship led by His Voice, coupled with the Word Gift, was essential in bringing us into the Lord’s Holy presence during all phases of the weekend, which included four teachings given by Deacon Larry and Andi Oney, evangelists, from New Orleans.

Andi Oney presented the first teaching, “The Lord of the Harvest” (Jesus) and compared the present time with that of John the Baptist, who was recognized as a voice crying out in the wilderness. *Today, ‘the wilderness is crying for a voice’*. She noted that he was sent by God as a prophetic voice, to gather His people together, much in the same way that he assigns us also at a time such as this. We have all been called through our Baptism in the Spirit and Fire. God wants our ultimate heart exposure, and is calling us to repentance and confession. To stay clean. Andi compared the ‘Now Times’ (a time of harvesting of souls) with that of the farmer at threshing time. The chaff and the wheat will be separated. God wants to crush our sins, so we become purified. Many do not know the freedom of the Holy Spirit and are not equipped to go out. *We must ‘get ready’; we are the Labourers. The Kingdom of God is at hand.*

The second teaching, by Deacon Larry, brings us to “The Harvest Field” namely that of souls. He noted that we are to fulfil our mission; to preach, teach and exhort; that we must participate in priestly, prophetic and healing services and proclaim who Jesus is to us. He stated that we will see rejection, but we must be strong and courageous, there is no ‘harvest’ without a seed being sown. We must do it with humility, have the right disposition, and claim the truth. He referred to Numbers 13:1-33 (Moses sends out 12 spies to the different areas of Canaan – to report on the conditions of the promised land, but because of fear, the majority of reports were negative.) He stated that the enemy is always bigger in our mind than he really is, and that we must stay away from negative people. He reinforced Andi’s message that we must repent, go to Mass, consecrate our families, and trust in God’s mercy; God will provide. In closing, he confirmed that God is calling us today to a fresh outpouring, a new anointing. **GO OUT!**

The third teaching focussed on the “Queen of the Harvest” (Our Blessed Mother). Andi asked us “Are we willing to pay the cost for God?” and that true worship is a sacrifice. She then reflected back to the time of David (in the old testament), how the cloud of God’s glory would appear – and how David dedicated himself to protecting God’s place of worship (the ARK of the Covenant) while bringing it back to Jerusalem. Andi then made several comparisons to the old and the New Ark of the Covenant - Mary. She also articulated that our Blessed Mother is recognized as the Ark of Jesus and the Ark of Peace, a Refuge, upon which people must enter. *Lift up your eyes; see that the fields are ripe for the harvest. Don’t let fear stop you. God is moving quickly – a current of grace – grace of the Holy Spirit - a new world of peace is possible.*

Deacon Larry brings it all together with "The Final Harvest" and begins his teaching with words spoken by St. Pope John Paul II. *We are standing in the greatest confrontation; the final confrontation of the church and the anti-church.*

He later referred to (Rev.1 and 7) when war broke out in the heavens between the angels; when satan was defeated by the blood of the lamb. He mentioned (historically) major times of failure in the church, and compared it to God using the Corona virus to set the stage in this time. He followed with a prophetic word, spoken by Fr. Michael Scanlan in 1976, that God always lets us know - *"My Word will go forth to my people; many hear, many may not; when you see everything is shut down...you will know what I am making ready."* Deacon Larry stressed that Revival is always preceded by Repentance, and referred to various biblical passages regarding the sign of the times – the end of the age. When the day comes there will be light; all will be renewed.

*"We need to Re- calibrate, Re-allocate, and Re- dedicate."*

Father Mark Cherry also delivered two powerful homilies, related to the theme of the weekend; that *these are unparalleled times with the absence of borders*. He affirmed that God has allowed COVID 19 and wants to radically intercede to show us the full stature of who He wants us to be. *We are the ones who will bring in the Harvest and we are the Overcomers. We must pray according to the will of God and see with the eyes of our hearts. Have the faith of God. God will show His face. ARE YOU READY?*

An important objective of the weekend was to offer prayers for healing. On Saturday we allotted two full hours during the day for accessing call-in prayer lines; we also held an evening Healing Service. Close to 80 calls were received by prayer teams across Canada and the US, and healings were claimed during the evening prayer time.

## **Now Is The Time**

The conference theme, "It Is Harvest Time" hit the nail on the head. As stated, it was powerful, prophetic and timely. We were taught many things and challenged in a number of ways, for example, two of Deacon Larry Oney's statements: 1. Repentance always precedes revival; and 2. John the Baptist was a voice crying out in the wilderness. Now the wilderness is crying out for a voice. This should cause each of us to sit back and reflect on what our response should be to each of those statements. We are in a different time and many of us are asking what's next? What am I supposed to do?

### **Let's look at Habakkuk 1:2-5 for a little clarity:**

*How long Yahweh am I to cry for help, while you will not listen;  
to cry oppression in your ear and you will not save?*

*Why do you set injustice before Me. Why do you look on where there is tyranny?  
Outrage and violence, this is all I see, all is contention, and discord flourishes.*

*And so the law loses its hold, and justice never shows itself.  
Yes, the wicked man gets the better of the upright, and so justice is seen to be distorted.*

*Cast your eyes over the nations; look and be amazed, astounded.  
For I am doing something in your own days; that you would not believe if you were told of it.*

Do you see? Do you see? Do you really see?

What happened in Habakkuk's time is happening today. Everything seems to be out of control, but, we must continue to trust that God is moving in our time. Now Is The Time! It's time for the harvest and it's time for us to respond to our Lord's call. But the question is how?

Firstly, I believe that we should take the powerful words of St. Pope John Paul II to heart: "*Do not be afraid!*" Jesus says exactly the same thing in Matthew 17:8, when He says to His disciples who had fallen down in fear at Gods appearance during the transfiguration, "*Stand up, do not be afraid!*" We are being told not to be afraid of God. When we are called, we are not to hesitate. Move now for now is the time.

Secondly, we need to "get our house in order." Just as we keep our homes neat and tidy we also need to do the same thing, figuratively, with our spiritual lives. Remember, repentance always precedes revival. Prayer, Reconciliation, and Eucharist are especially important as we draw near the end of the age. It is time to prepare. Do not be afraid. Be ready for what God calls you to, for "Now Is The Time."
